

PROFILE

Johnathan Batista dos Santos, a Brazilianborn, Dublin-based composer, arranger, and performer, is known for his ability to connect and collaborate. His work, which ranges from contemporary concert music to jazz, has been enriched by his collaborations with artists in different fields, a testament to his ability to inspire and be inspired.

His engaged practice includes co-founding a Theatre of the Oppressed group in Dublin with theatre maker Orla Devlin, based on Augusto Boal's methodologies. This initiative, supported by the Arts Council's Artist in the Community (AIC) Scheme and mentored by socially engaged artist Dana Olărescu, has been a cornerstone of his work.

His projects include a collaborative musical piece created with non-musicians and a new play currently developing through a collective creation process. These experiences have profoundly shaped his artistic vision and informed his approach to community-centred and participatory art.

In 2021, Johnathan Batista was commissioned by LASC (Latin America Solidarity Centre) to write and record music commenting on Ecosystem Restoration; since then, the group has performed the music in places such as "The Kildare Jazz Festival" and the "Lulu Jazz Club" in The Whelan's.

As the leader of the Johnathan Batista Group, one of the most exciting new ensembles emerging from the Irish Jazz scene, he brings a unique approach. The group strives to find a dialectical balance between contemporary art music and popular postmodern music, using improvisation not just as a means of developing musical form, but as a powerful vehicle for artistic expression.
